- Scholarship awards by college or university in dollar amount

(The Committee may use the annual cost of school fees and other scholarship awards as part of the economic criteria for LRBC award).

All high school graduates who will be attending a college or a university in the United States, and who were not awarded a scholarship will receive a onetime book stipend of \$400. Recipients must show proof of attendance to a college or university before a check will be issued for book stipend reimbursement.
